

# **Crime complaint : The Rt Hon Theresa Mary May MP**

**Alleged crime(s):** Misconduct in Public Office

**By:** Theresa Mary May MP, in her official capacity as Prime Minister and First Lord of the Treasury ("The Complainee")

## **Details:**

1. It is understood that the Treasury have produced in the region of fifty Impact Assessments of various scenarios of the economic effects of a UK exit from the European Union ("the Studies").
2. These Studies have not been released to the public or Parliament for scrutiny.
3. The Government has to date refused to release the Studies.
4. In 2015 the Queen enacted the EU Referendum Bill authorising an advisory referendum.
5. The result of the Referendum as defined in the Act was to be advisory and non-binding, and to be duly considered by Parliament, but without obligation to follow any particular course of action.
6. The advisory Referendum took place on 23 June 2016 and the result is public knowledge.
7. Theresa May MP assumed the office of Prime Minister on 13 July 2016.
8. The clear duty of the Complainee upon assumption of the office of Prime Minister and First Lord of the Treasury was to instruct the Treasury to prepare Impact Assessments of the effects of a UK exit from the European Union in order to be able to advise Parliament should Parliament be required to consider action following the result of the Referendum.
9. The Complainant does not know how many such Studies were prepared before 29 March 2017 since neither the Complainee nor the Treasury will provide such information.
10. However the Complainant has been advised in confidence that all or the vast majority of such Studies prepared forecast negative economic consequences for the UK in the event of the UK exiting the EU.
11. Nevertheless, the Complainee instructed or authorised the Secretary of State the Rt Hon David Davis MP to present a Bill (the EU (Notification of Withdrawal) Bill) to the House of Commons on 31 January 2017.
12. In presenting the Bill, the Secretary of State failed to submit any of the above mentioned Studies for due consideration by Parliament.

13. Members of Parliament have a duty to have regard to the national interest when performing their duties . (MP Code of Conduct)
14. Members of Parliament debating and voting on the Bill were prevented from having due regard to the national interest in the absence of disclosure of those Studies prepared prior to 31 January 2017.
15. Further, on 29 March 2017 the Complainee in her capacity as Prime Minister wrote a letter to President Donald Tusk purporting to give formal notice of the UK's intention to exit the EU in accordance with Article 50(2) TFEU.
16. It is believed that the Complainee took this action with full knowledge of the Studies prepared prior to 29 March 2017.
17. The Complainant is advised in confidence that all or the vast majority of Studies prepared up to that date forecast negative economic consequences for the UK in the event of the UK exiting the EU.
18. Therefore the Complainee took an action which she fully knew was likely to be against the national interest. This is believed to constitute a Common Law offence of Misconduct in Public Office.
19. Further, it is believed that the Complainee has withheld or prevented disclosure of the Studies including any further Studies prepared since 29 March 2017, and continues to do. This is believed to constitute a further Common Law offence of Misconduct in Public Office.
20. The Complainant is unable to present the evidence required to support this Complaint since the Studies are not available to the public. The Complainant believes that in order to properly consider the seriousness and validity of the allegations the Police should require the Complainee to make the Studies available for examination. In the interests of justice and the public interest the Studies should also be made available to the Complainant .
